Duration of the program: 3 years

Tuition fees per semester (UGX): 1,200,000 Mode: dual mode (online and local support)

Admission Requirements

Students will be admitted to the Bachelor of Information Science degree program through three avenues: Direct Entry, Mature Entry and Diploma Entry Schemes.

Direct Entry:

Candidates seeking admission through the direct entry scheme require at least two principal passes at same sitting in Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) (UACE).

Diploma Entry

- At least a second class (lower division) Diploma in Information Science, Library Science, Records Management, Computer Science, Engineering, Statistics, Information Technology or a related field from any recognized Institution.
- At least one principal and two subsidiaries passes at the same sitting in UACE.

Mature Age Entry Scheme

For admission under mature age, a candidate must at least:-

- Be 25 years old at the time of application
- Have Uganda Certificate of Education of at least 3 year standing item
- Have passed the university mature age entry examinations.

Description of Program

This course offers training focused on the use of information technology and the processing of information products. It is designed to train students in the management, retrieval, packaging and distributing organization of information. This program seeks to produce graduates who will be able to collect, process, store, retrieve and make available information necessary for the business growth of the organization so as to improve utility and effectiveness in organizations. The Bachelor of Information Science aims at developing high quality human resources who can fully maximize the utility of information in organizations.

Admission requirements:

Students will be admitted to the Bachelor of Information Science degree program through three avenues: Direct Entry, Mature Entry and Diploma Entry Schemes

Direct Entry

- A principal pass in Mathematics.
- At least two principal passes at the same sitting in Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) of which one of them MUST be in Mathematics

Diploma Entry:

Applicants applying on the diploma scheme should full the following requirements;

- At least a 2nd class (Lower division) Diploma in Computer Science, Engineering, Statistics or any other diploma with either Mathematics or Computer Science, as one of the subjects from any recognized Institution.
- Have obtained at least one subsidiary pass in Mathematics in UACE
- Have obtained at least one principal pass and two subsidiary passes at same sitting in UACE.

Mature Age Entry Scheme:

For admission under the Mature Age Entry Scheme, a candidate must have sat and passed the university mature age entry examinations from a recognized center. To sit for university mature age, the candidate must have age of at least 25 years and must have completed Uganda Certicate of Education (UCE) or its equivalent at least 3 years earlier. The candidate must possess at least a Credit in Mathematics at UCE.

Brief description of the program:

The course focuses on areas of hardware, data communications and software engineering. This program blends theory and practice into a learning experience that develops skills applicable to complex real-world problems in the field of computer engineering. Students study the design of digital hardware and software including communications systems, computers and devices.
